

R.E and Celebration of the Word:

- **Branch 5: To the Ends of the Earth**

Pupils will learn how Mass today follows the pattern of the early Church, discover how Jesus is present in the Word and deepen their understanding of the Holy Trinity.

Maths:

Times tables - Children will prepare for their multiplication check in June by revising all the multiplication facts and playing times tables games.

History/Geography

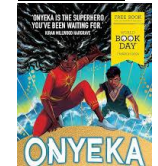
- **Local area**- Children will learn about the history of Bolton with a focus on the Industrial Revolution and its impact on the town.
