

Dear Year 6 Parents/guardians,

As a school we have decided that on the days they have PE, children will now come to school dressed in their full PE kit and will wear it all day. Starting from tomorrow (Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September) if your child has PE, they <u>MUST</u> come dressed in their kit: ST Ethelbert's/WHITE PE t-shirt, BLUE PE shorts and suitable sports trainers.
