R.E and Collective Worship:

- **Beginnings** – Children will understand the different types of beginnings we come across in our life. They will learn that God is present in every beginning.

- **Signs and Symbols** – In this unit children will learn about the different signs and symbols that are involved in the sacrament of Baptism.

- **Preparations** – Children will learn about the four weeks of Advent in preparation of the birth of Jesus.

Maths:

- Place value children will learn how to use a place value chart and be able to partition numbers to 100. They will begin to count in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s.
- Addition and subtraction children will begin to learn to add and subtract 2-digit numbers and be able to compare them.
- **Shape** children will learn facts about 2-D and 3-D shapes and lines of symmetry.

<u>D.T / Art</u>

- **D.T** – Food Technology – Children will find out what the favourite pizzas in the class are. They will also try different bread-based products and pizza toppings to help them plan and make their own pizza.

 - ART – Portraits in the style Giuseppe Arcimboldi –
Children will look at the work of Giuseppe Arcimbaldi and experiment with different techniques including painting, collage and printing. There final piece will be a portrait made from fruit and flowers.
