How you can help at home

Maths

- Practise counting with your child 1- 10 first, then 1-20, then back from 10 and back from 20. They need to be able to do this without any prompting from you and without missing any numbers out.
- Look out for numbers in the environment – on road signs, door numbers, on bus stops etc.
- There will be a short meeting about helping with maths on Thursday February 1st at 2pm.

Talking

Please watch a short TV programme with your child. Watch it through once and ask your child to tell you what they have seen and heard. Help them to speak in full sentences making sure they use the little words like 'on', 'in' 'to' etc. Help them to learn new words.

Cbeebies is brilliant to help extend knowledge and vocabulary. Just google cbeebies I player. My World Kitchen, Andy's adventures, Go Jetters, Jojo and Gran are just a few of the programs that you can watch.

Reading and Writing

- Many children are now bringing home a reading book. They should read this to you at least 4 times over the week (on different days)
- Practise the words that I send home until your child knows them off by heart.
- Practise writing the words until your child can write them without copying.
- There will be a short meeting about reading and writing on Thursday 18th January at 2.30pm. Please do your best to attend.
- Check your child's reading folder every day and take out any letters, pictures etc.
