RE

In RE this half term we be will learning about Lent and Easter.

We will learn that spring is a time when things begin to grow, and notice the flowers in the school grounds begin to bloom. We will learn about baby animals.

Phonics

In phonics we will be continuing to develop our listening skills through songs, games and in our play.

We will be continuing phase 1 phonics using our 'Supersonic phonics friends' scheme.

We will be listening closely to hear the initial sounds in our names and popular brands eg W for Willow and P for Peppa pig.

Maths

In maths this half term we will be developing our subitising skills, saying whether there are 3 or not 3 objects in a group and recognising when a 5 frame is full, empty or partly full.

We will begin to recognise numerals 1, 2, and 3.

We will be learning to find the longer/shorter, heavier /lighter or more/less full objects.
