

Religious Education:

Branch one: Creation and covenant

Children will revisit the Creation story, learning that God made the world good and blessed it. They will reflect on being made in God's image, caring for others and the earth, and appreciating Creation with gratitude and wonder.

Branch two: Prophecy and promise

Children will learn about what happens at Mass, focusing on listening to God's Word and sharing gifts. They will also explore St Matthew's nativity, discovering Joseph's role and Jesus as the Messiah promised in Scripture.

Maths:

Place Value – Children will learn the value of, order, estimate, partition and round numbers up to 10,000

Roman numerals- Pupils will learn to read and write the Roman numerals to 100. - Children will develop their skills reading and interpreting bar charts and line graphs.

Arithmetic – Children will add and subtract 2 four-digit numbers. Pupils will complete the times tables and division facts up to 12s.

Area- Pupils will be investigating area.

D.T / Art

* **Art** – Pupils will learn about the life and works of L.S. Lowry.

* **D.T** – The children will be looking at seasonal food and how to cook using British ingredients available all year round. To show and understand about eating seasonal food as part of a healthy, varied diet.

Music: Musical instrument

The children will be learning how to play different chords on the recorder.

Science:

- **Animals including humans** – During this unit, children will describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans. Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions. Construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey. Describe how teeth and gums have to be cared for in order to keep them healthy.

History/Geography

- **Ancient Egyptians** – Children will learn about where and how Egyptians lived. They will investigate who the gods and pharaohs were and the mummification process.
- **Megacities** – Children will learn what makes a city a megacity and be able to identify them.
